The Puget Sound chapter of the American Society of Heating Refrigerating and Air-Conditioning Engineers (ASHRAE) invites students enrolled at the University of Washington (UW), North Seattle College (NSC), Shoreline Community College (SCC), and other institutions in Puget Sound region to apply for the Puget Sound ASHRAE scholarship. Students of other HVAC programs or programs of ASHRAE related industries in the Puget Sound area are also welcome to apply.

The scholarships will be applied toward tuition at the recipient's respective school. The scholarship funds will go directly to the school and will be credited to the student's name for Summer or Fall academic quarters of 2017. The award amount is \$2000.

Eligibility:

Applicants must be enrolled in one of the programs listed below for the **Summer or Fall 2017** academic quarters to receive an award.

- UW students must be registered full time in the College of Engineering or College of Built Environments.
- NSC students must be registered in the HVAC program.
- SCC Students must be registered in the Clean Energy Technology Program.
- Students from other institutions must be registered in ASHRAE related program.

Future students (individuals who have been accepted into one of the above programs for the Summer or Fall 2017 academic quarters) <u>are</u> eligible to apply. Students graduating in Spring of 2017 who will not be enrolled for the Summer or Fall 2017 academic quarters <u>are not</u> eligible to apply.

Criteria:

Applications will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Academic transcripts
- Essay responses
- Preference will be given to ASHRAE Student Members (just \$20 to register for the year).

Puget Sound ASHRAE will select the award recipients from applications received. Puget Sound ASHRAE is not obligated to award scholarships to students from each school applying.

Deadline Apply by May 6th to be considered for the Fall 2017 award.
